

## Marina Park Rental Guide

Marina Park on Powell Street features a serene setting with beautiful site lines of the San Francisco Bay. This includes the Berkeley and Oakland hillsides, the Bay and Golden Gate Bridges, and a magnificent view of San Francisco's skyline.

Popular events held at Marina Park include:

- Family Barbecues
- Children's Birthday Parties
- Corporate Picnics
- Weddings

As in all City of Emeryville parks, if your event has 49 people or less you may use Marina Park without reservations. However, if you are planning a more formal event that requires a specific date, location, and time it is recommended that you reserve a specific site at Marina Park by completing a Park Rental Application. Please note that the entire eastern side of the Marina Park is leased to the Emeryville Marina, which observes a strict 'first come, first served' policy to ensure access to the public and boaters.

If your event has 50 people or more, you are required to fill out a Community Events Application to hold your event. Community Events will increase the park reservation rate.

## **Parking:**

The Marina Park has limited parking to accommodate the many visitors of this beautiful park. Events over 50 people will be expected to provide a parking plan on the Community Events Permit Application. Illegal Parking is strictly enforced! Please follow the posted rules on parking and avoid an expensive ticket or being towed. Alternative parking can be found along the Powell Street in accordance to the posted signs.

### Specific Lot Info:

- Lot 1 (North) - 66 parking spaces + 4 handicapped accessible spaces + 4 motorcycle spaces
- Lot 2 (Middle) - 50 parking spaces + 2 handicapped accessible spaces
- Lot 3 (South) - 38 parking spaces + 2 handicapped accessible spaces

## **Restrooms:**

There is a newly renovated public restroom located on the eastern side of Powell Street in the middle of the park. Both sides of the restroom have a hose nozzle and working water for your convenience. Please be aware that the Emeryville Marina also operates a private, key entry bathroom on the eastern side of Powell Street. The public restroom is colored in natural tones, while the private restroom is painted white.
