

GENERAL SERVICE INFORMATION

Garbage, Recycling & Organics Cart pickup is every week.
Set all carts out curbside by 6 am.

Pickup Tips:

- Holidays are Labor day, Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's day. When a holiday falls on a weekday, pickup will be one day later for the rest of that week.
- Prevent theft and blight, Emeryville Blight Ordinance mandates carts be put away within 24 hours after pickup or be subject to city fines.
- Recycle and reduce waste. Smaller size garbage cans can help you save money... Call Waste Management of Alameda County at (510) 613-8710 for options.

on a rotation basis. Available to Alameda County residents. No appointment needed.

Free Holiday Tree-Cycling Pickup

Trees are picked up curbside during the first 2 weeks of January, on your regular pickup day. Only clean trees will be picked up: no "snow" flocking, stands or decorations. Clean trees must be cut to less than 5' tall.

Weekly Pickup of All Carts.

RECYCLE: BOTTLES, CANS & PAPER IN GREY CART

BOTTLES, JARS, CANS, FOIL, PAPER & CARDBOARD



- Aerosol Cans must be empty
- Clean aluminum foil
- Paper clips, staples, junk mail with windows and "stickies" are OK

Tip: Flattening boxes and cans will save space in you cart.

Do Not Include:

- Yogurt/margarine tubs
- Plastic six-pack rings
- Styrofoam
- Clam-shell type containers
- Drinking glasses or mugs
- Ceramics of any kind



RECYCLE: PLANT DEBRIS & FOOD SCRAPS IN GREEN CART

PLANT DEBRIS

- Weeds, pine needles, leaves and grass
- Branches and unpainted, untreated wood (must be less than 4' long and 6" around)



FOOD SCRAPS

All food products:

- Meat, bones and seafood
- Fruit, vegetables, bread and cheese
- Tea bags, coffee grounds and filters

Food-soiled paper:

- Paper plates, towels and napkins
- Pizza boxes and Waxed paper containers



- Collect food scraps in your new kitchen pail, empty into the Green Organics Cart.



Tip: Line pail with milk carton, ice cream container, newspaper or paper bag, put it all in the Green Organics Cart.

For extra yard debris and compostables, use large paper gardening bags; available at most hardware stores.

Do Not Include:

- Plastic, metal or glass of any kind
- Liquids or grease
- Pots, dirt, rocks or concrete
- Hazardous materials
- Pesticide contaminated materials
- Dog or cat wastes and litter



RECYCLE: USED MOTOR OIL & FILTER IN PROVIDED KIT

USED MOTOR OIL

- Place filled Motor Oil Recycling Jug and Filter inside kit curbside, next to Garbage Cart. Do not put kit in cart.

Call Waste Management at (510) 613-8710 to have a free Motor Oil Recycling Kit delivered. Use the provided kit to qualify for curbside pickup.



This program is for used motor oil only; for cooking oil recycling, call The City of Emeryville at (510) 596-3728.



DISPOSAL: GARBAGE IN BURGUNDY CART

NON-RECYCLABLE & NON-HAZARDOUS ITEMS

- Non-recyclable plastics such as: Bags, tubs and Styrofoam
- Diapers, pet waste and litter
- Broken household items
- All items must fit inside the cart.

Tip: Take used, clean plastic bags to your grocery store for recycling.

Do Not Include:

- Dirt, rocks or cement
- Hazardous materials
- Pesticides and herbicides
- Chemicals and solvents
- Syringes and sharps
