

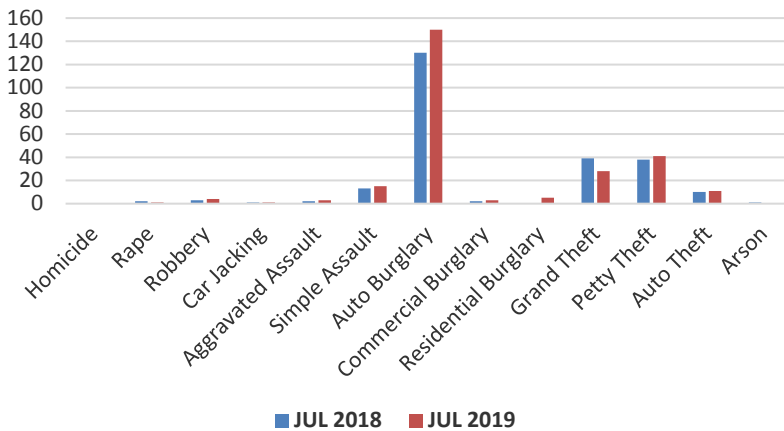

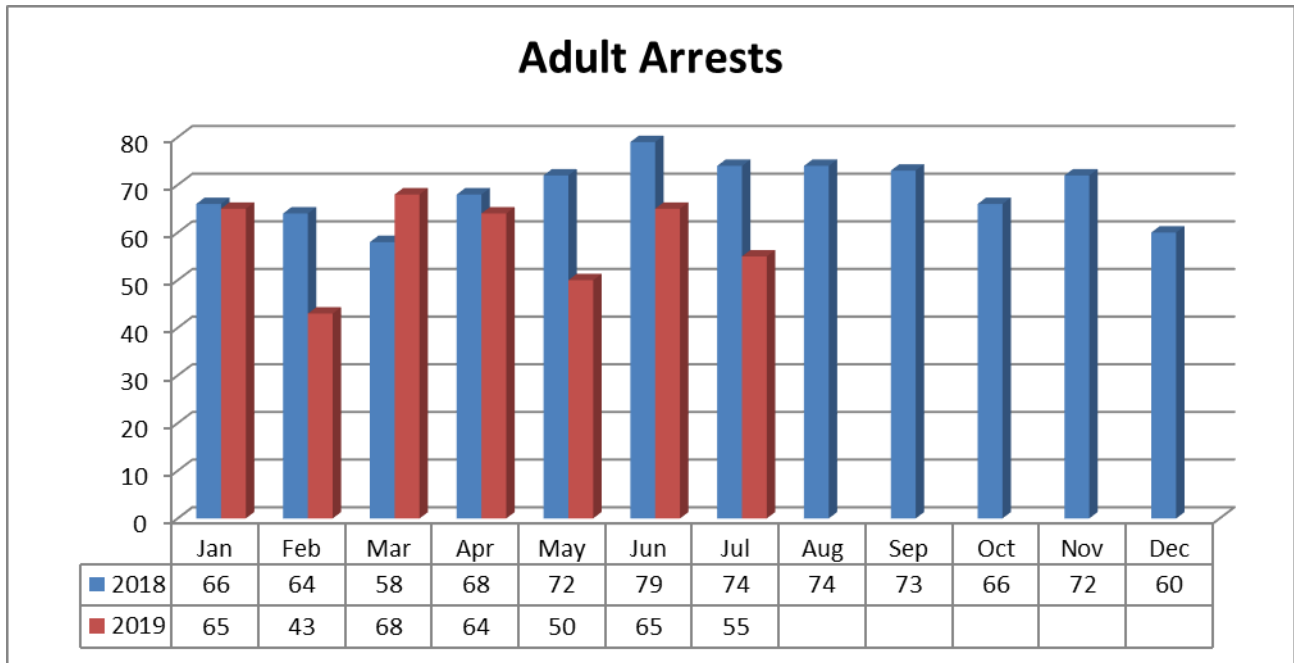

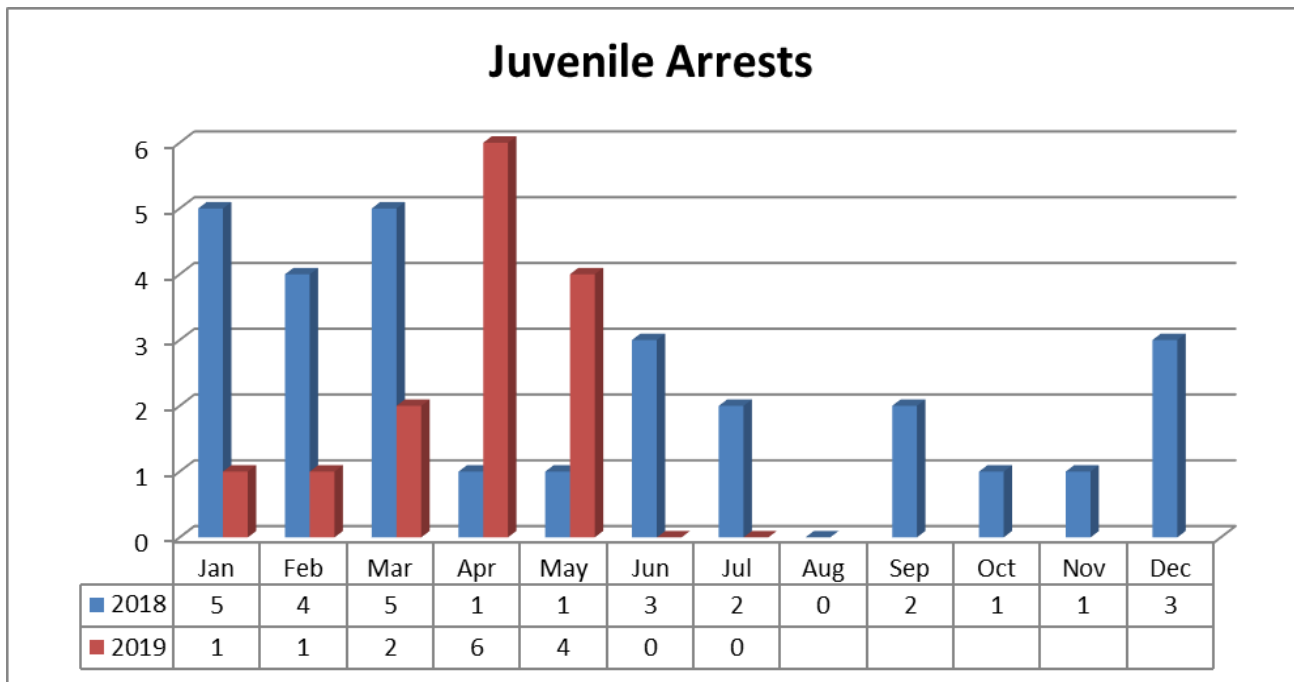

Rape: In District 5 at 56XX Bay St., a sexual assault occurred.

Robbery: In District 3 at 64th St. & Christie Ave., a strongarm robbery occurred. LOSS: Cell Phone. SUSPECT: #1 Male, 18-25 years old, 5'8" to 5'9", short hair, wearing a black shirt with white writing. The suspect fled to a silver Honda Civic occupied with one male driver. #2 Male, 30s, short hair and a beard. In District 4 at 2000 Powell St., (Turn-a-bout area) a strongarm robbery occurred. LOSS: Laptop. SUSPECTS: (3) Male juveniles wearing jeans and hoodies. In District 9 in the parking lot of Pak N Save, 3889 San Pablo Ave., a robbery at gunpoint occurred. LOSS: \$200. SUSPECTS: #1 Male, 30s, 5'10", 190 lbs., wearing a black ski mask with the eyes and mouth cut out, a black hoodie, black jeans and armed with a semi-auto pistol. #2 Male, 30s, 5'4", 160 lbs., wearing a black ski mask with the eyes and mouth cut out, a black hoodie and black jeans. In front of Little Caesars, 1199 40th St., an attempted robbery occurred. Two males attempted to take a male victim's cell phone. The suspects fled the area without the loss.

Car Jacking: In the parking lot of Nordstrom's Rack, 3839 Emery St., #100 a female was car jacked. Suspect: Male, 20 years old, wearing a black shirt and red pants. The suspect had an unknown weapon bulging from his waistband. VICTIM VEHICLE: 2017 Dodge Charger, white. Richmond Police Department recovered the unoccupied vehicle the following day.

Aggravated Assault: In District 3 in front of the Allegro Ballroom, 5855 Christie Ave., a male reported being pepper sprayed by a female acquaintance. In District 7 at 40th St. & San Pablo Ave., a male swung a knife at another male because he thought the person stole his bicycle. There were no injuries. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. In District 9 in front of Subway, 3999 San Pablo Ave., A male transient punched an elderly male on the face causing the victim to fall and bump his head on the concrete. The suspect walked away from the scene and was gone upon EPD arrival.

Commercial Burglary: In District 2 at Los Moles, 1320 65th St., POE: Side door – Window pane removed. LOSS: (3) Cash registers. In District 6 Point of View Graphics 1555 Park Ave., POE: Front door window – Shattered. LOSS: Computer. In District 9 at Home Depot, 3838 Hollis St., a male suspect entered the store and purchased goods using someone else’s identity and credit card.

Residential Burglary: In District 6 at 43XX Horton #X, POE: Front door – Left ajar. LOSS: Laptop computer. SUSPECT: Male wearing a hoodie. At 15XX Park Ave., #XXX, POE: Front window ajar – Screen torn open. LOSS: \$100 cash. In District 8 at 10XX 45th St., POE: Unknown. LOSS: Several miscellaneous personal items. At 10XX 46th St., POE: Storage facility. LOSS: Miscellaneous electronics. EPD identified and arrested the suspect days later during a pedestrian stop.

Auto Theft: (11) Vehicles were stolen including (1) motorcycle. (6) Vehicles were recovered, (4) of which were recovered intact, (1) vehicle was damaged and stripped, and (1) vehicle had major stripping. Various makes were stolen.
