

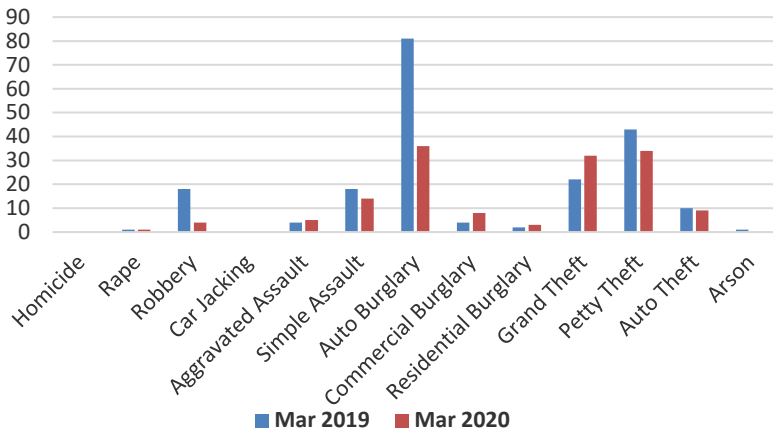

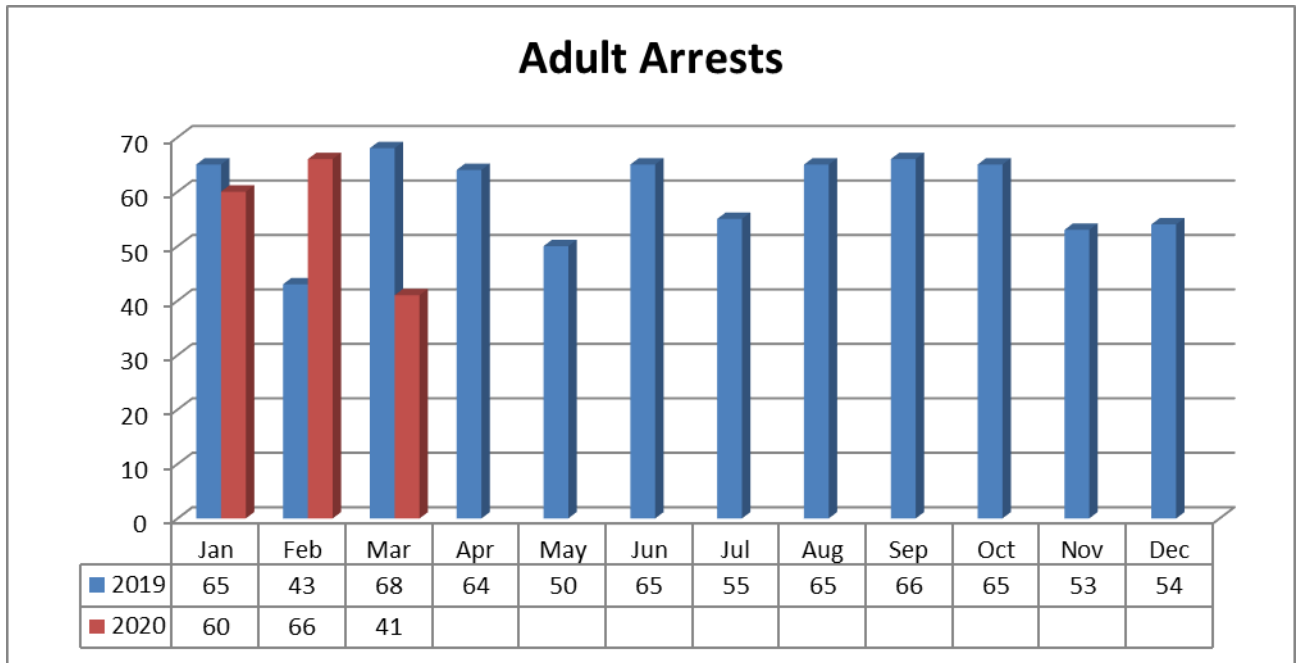

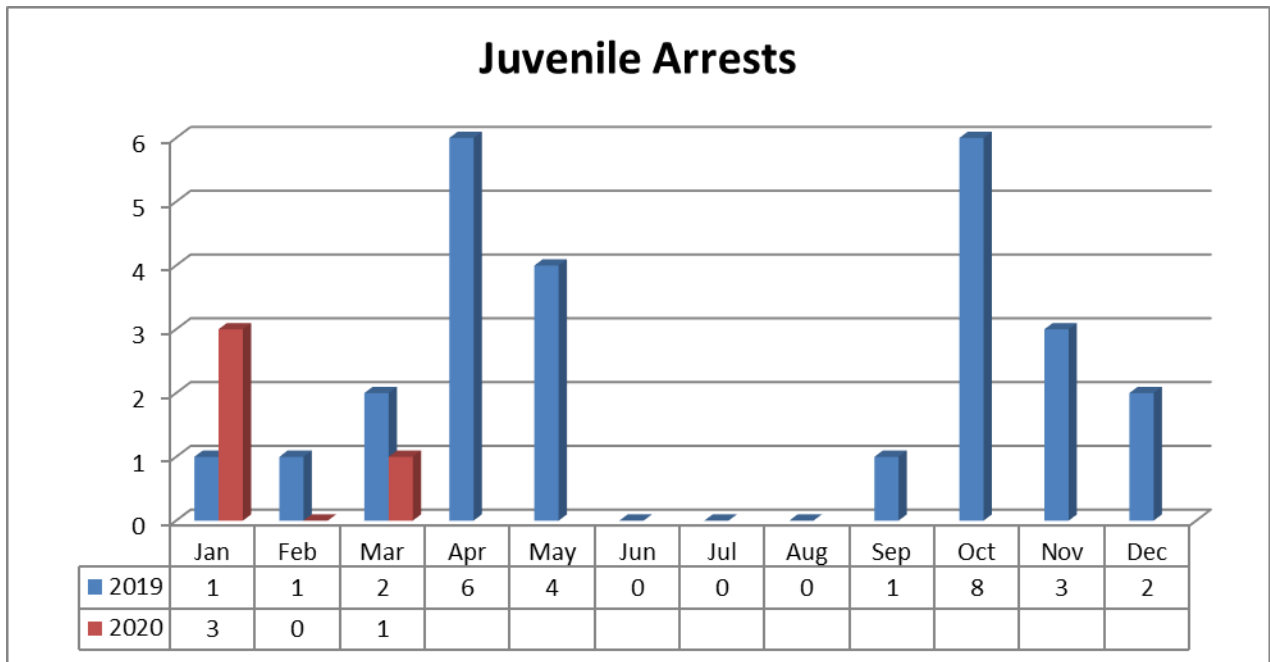

Rape: In District 7 on the 1400 block of 40th St., an elderly female reports being sexually assaulted, however she's not sure if the incident was a dream or reality.

Robbery: In District 4 in the Emeryville Marina, 3310 Powell St., a robbery at gunpoint occurred. LOSS: \$300 cash and a wedding ring. SUSPECT: Male, 6'0, 200 lbs., wearing a brown jacket and blue jeans. In District 5 at Sephora, 5626 Bay St., two shoplifters committed a strong-arm robbery. LOSS: Cosmetics. SUSPECTS: A male and female, 19-25 years old, wearing puff coats. In District 6 in front of Grifols, 4560 Horton St., A Grifols employee was robbed at gunpoint. LOSS: A black Coach Purse, iPhone, and tote bag. SUSPECT: Male, 40-50 years old, 5'8", wearing a white beanie, a camouflage jacket, and light colored sweat pants. In District 8 in front of 7Eleven, 4000 San Pablo Ave., a fight occurred between two males resulting in one male going through the other male's pockets removing coins. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter.

Aggravated Assault: In District 1 on the 5800 block of Beaudry St., an argument over finances resulted in a man attempting to smother his wife with a pillow. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. In District 2 on the 6200 block of Doyle St., a domestic violence incident resulted in the male throwing a rubber mallet and a vacuum cleaner at his girlfriend and her daughter. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. In District 3 on the 6363 block of Christie Ave., a domestic violence incident resulted in the female running over her boyfriend with his vehicle. The victim sustained a minor knee injury and did not request medical. EPD arrested the girlfriend shortly thereafter. In District 9 in the parking lot of Pak N Save, 3889 San Pablo Ave., an argument between patrons regarding social distancing resulted in the male deliberately backing his car into the female's car two or three times.

Commercial Burglary: In District 2 at Los Moles, 1320 65th St., POE: Front door – Glass panel removed. LOSS: (2) Cash registers both containing \$150 dollars. At Sunderstorm 6613 Hollis St., ATTEMPT, a crowbar was found wedged between the rear door's frame. At 5835 Doyle St. Ste#C, POE: Door – Glass break. LOSS: None. In District 3 at 6251 Shellmound St., (apartment under construction) POE: South side door – Pried. LOSS: None, door knob damaged. In District 5 at Ave Leasing Office, 5684 Bay St., POE: Door – Pried. LOSS: (11) Amazon packages opened with contents missing, a laptop, an iPad, and (3) rent checks. At Zumiez, 5677 Bay St., ATTEMPT, Bay Street Security saw a male suspect with a crowbar attempting to break into the business. When EPD arrived on the scene, the suspect entered a vehicle occupied by a male passenger and fled the scene. SUSPECT VEHICLE: 2012 Lexis, 4-Door, black, with a felony warrant out of Daly City. At Sleep Number, 5683 Bay St., ATTEMPT, POE: An unknown suspect forced a small hole through the wall next to the emergency door. No entry was made. At the Bay Street Mall Kiosk across from P.F. Chang, ATTEMPT, POE: Window – Male suspect threw an object at the window and left the area.

Residential Burglary: In District 4 at X Commodore Dr. POE: Bicycle storage locker. LOSS: Bicycle seat and post. In District 8 at 10XX 41st St., ATTEMPT, POE: Front door, rear door, and rear window – Pried. No entry made. At 11XX 40th St., POE: Bicycle storage locker. LOSS: (2) Bicycles.
