

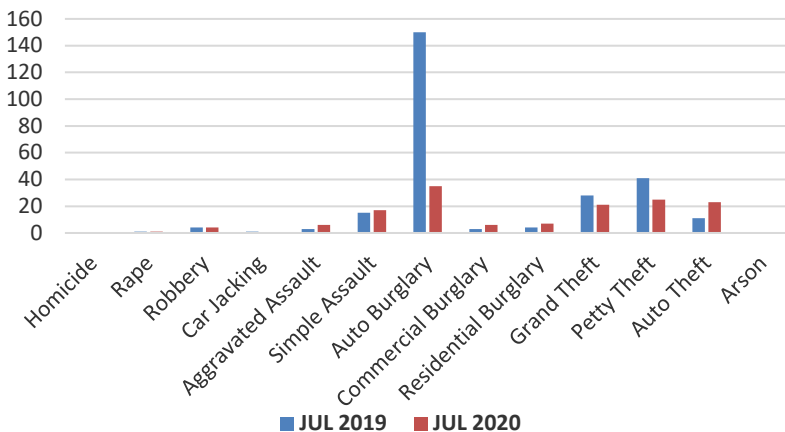

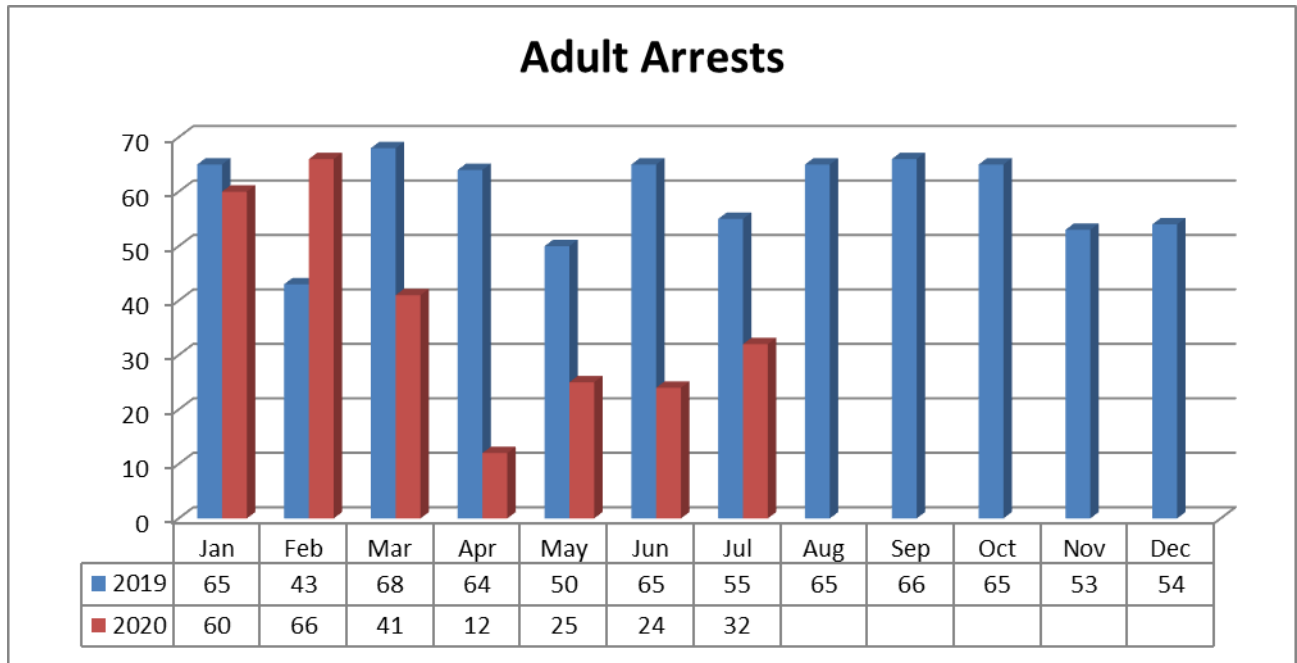

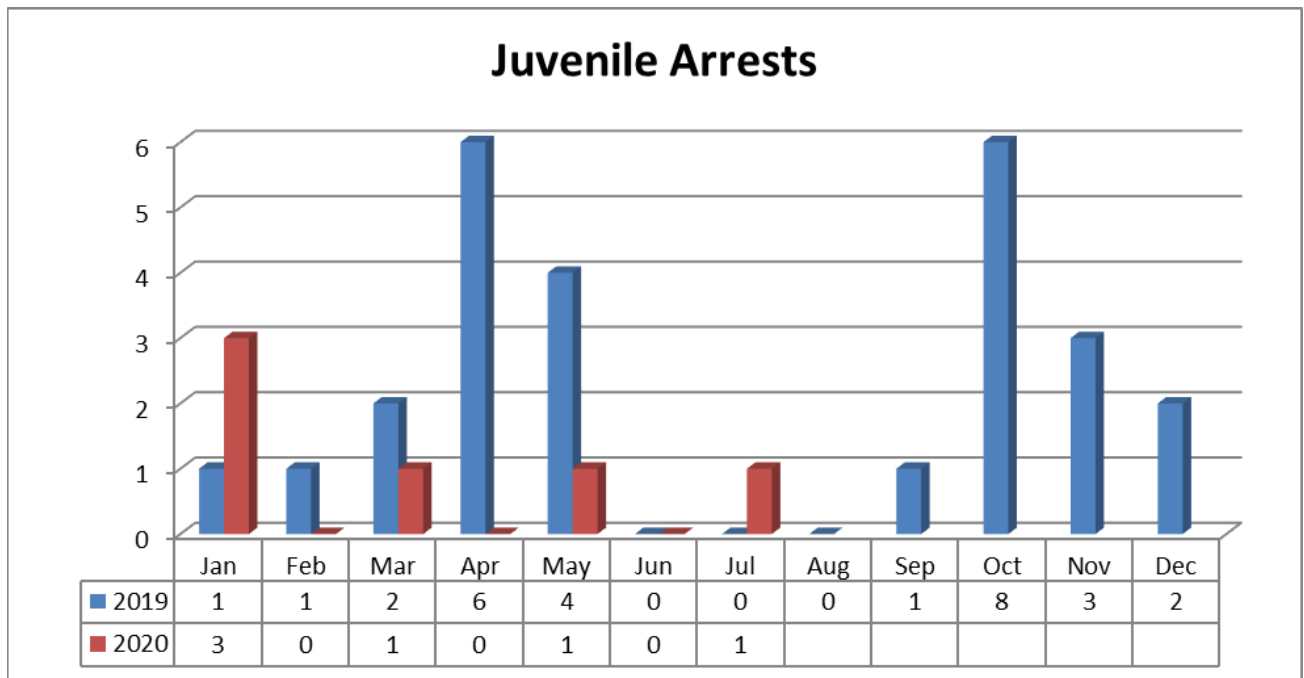
Adult and Juvenile Arrests YTD 2019 and 2020

Rape: In District 3 on the 6300 block of Christie Ave., (Late report- December 2017) a female reports her boyfriend, at the time, forced her to have sexual intercourse with him while she was under the influence of alcohol.

Robbery: In District 2 at Menus and Music, 1462 66th St., a strong-arm robbery occurred. LOSS: Employee's wallet. SUSPECT: Male, 24 years old, 5'10". The suspect fled to a vehicle and left the area. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Possibly a two door Honda, unknown color, with damage to the right front bumper. In District 5 in front of Ross Dress for Less, 5733 Christie Ave., a strong-arm robbery occurred. LOSS: A Rockhopper bicycle, gray, with purple handlebars. SUSPECT: Male, wearing a blue hat, no further description. In District 9 at Nordstrom Rack, 3839 Emery St., #100 a female shoplifter accompanied by a male filled a large bag with store merchandise and proceeded to exit the store passing all points of sale. The male suspect acted as if he had a weapon and made threats when he was approached by loss prevention. The couple fled the area in a vehicle. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Chevy Tahoe, white, no further description. In District 10 at Target, 1555 40th St., a male suspect put on a pair of brass knuckles and threatened to hit a store employee. Both suspects passed all points of sale, exited the store with store merchandise and entered a vehicle. SUSPECTS: (2) Males, and (1) female. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Toyota, silver, reported stolen to Fairfield Police Department.

Aggravated Assault: In District 4 at Bay Super Shell, 1800 ½ Powell St., a refusal of service caused an irate customer to punch the plexiglass and throw a bottle of wine at the clerk striking her on the hand. SUSPECT: Male, late 20s, early 30s, wearing a white shirt. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Mitsubishi, silver. **In District 5 on the 5500 block of Shellmound St.,** a domestic violence incident between two females resulted in one female choking the other. EPD arrested one of the females shortly afterwards. **In District 7 in front of Arizmendi, 4301 San Pablo Ave.,** a domestic violence incident resulted in a female being choked by her boyfriend. EPD arrested the boyfriend shortly afterwards. **In the parking lot of IHOP, 4101 San Pablo Ave.,** a male suspect pepper sprayed another male without provocation. **In District 9 on the 1200 block 40th St.,** a domestic violence incident resulted in mutual combat, in which a husband choked his wife.

Commercial Burglary: In District 2 at Glashaus Garage 6466 Hollis St., POE: Garage. LOSS/RECOVERED: A Jamis unisex bicycle cut from the bike rack. EPD arrested a male suspect shortly afterwards. **In District 3 at Public Storage, 6501 Shellmound St.,** an unknown suspect(s) burgled a storage unit. LOSS: A keyboard, a computer router, a Swiss bag, and a 55" television. **At 6301 Shellmound St.,** POE: Mailroom – Key fob used for entry. LOSS: Several packages and a bicycle. SUSPECTS: (1) Male, and (2) females, no further description. **In District 9 at Pak N Save, 3889 San Pablo Ave (Late report from May 2020- Civil Unrest.)** The business was looted. **At Ashley Furniture, 3839 Emery St., #300 (Late report from May 2020-Civil Unrest.)** The business was looted. **At Bridgecourt Apartments, 1325 40th St.,** POE: Apartment mailbox – Forced open. LOSS: Mail.

Residential Burglary: In District 1 at 20X Liquid Sugar Dr., POE: Unknown. Two suspects entered the building and attempted to steal a bicycle. EPD arrested one of the suspects shortly thereafter. **At 12XX 65th St.,** POE: Garage – No signs of forced entry. LOSS: (2) Bicycles and miscellaneous items. SUSPECT: A male, medium build, wearing a white mask, a dark sweater and tan pants. **In District 3 at 64XX Shellmound St.,** (Domestic Violence) POE: Door – Kicked open. NO LOSS. **In District 7 at 55XX Doyle St.,** POE: Rear Door – Possibly unlocked. LOSS: (2) Laptops and a Nintendo Switch. **At 33XX Powell St.,** POE: Storage locker – Lock cut. LOSS: Bicycle. **In District 8 at 11XX 40th St.,** (ATTEMPT ONLY.) **At 39XX Adeline St.,** POE: Garage. NO LOSS. EPD arrested a male suspect shortly thereafter.

Auto Theft: (23) Vehicles were stolen this month, (11) vehicles were recovered and (2) vehicles were attempts only. (4) Vehicles were recovered intact, (5) vehicles were damaged, (2) vehicles had minor stripping. (10) Vehicles are still outstanding. Hondas and Fords were the most popular vehicles stolen.
