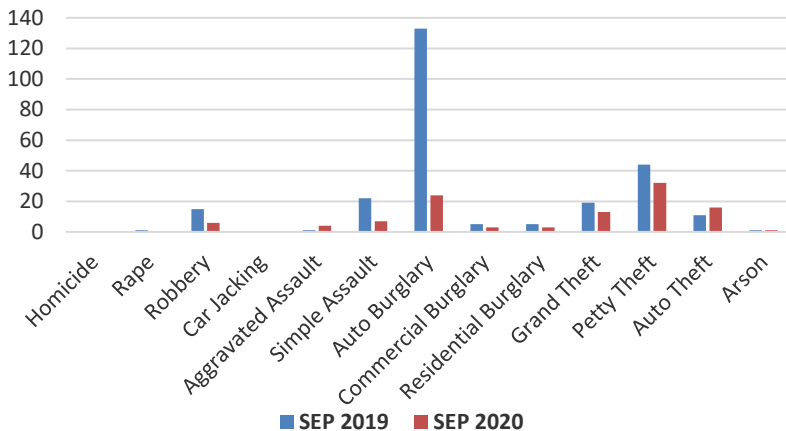

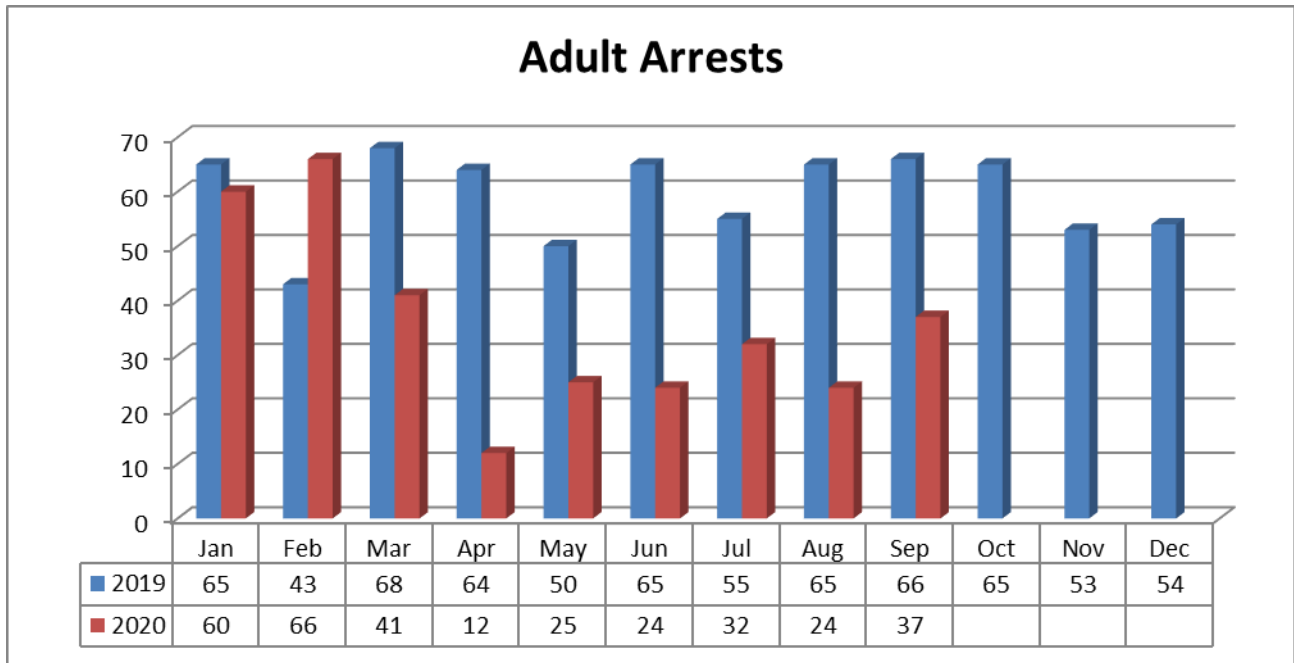

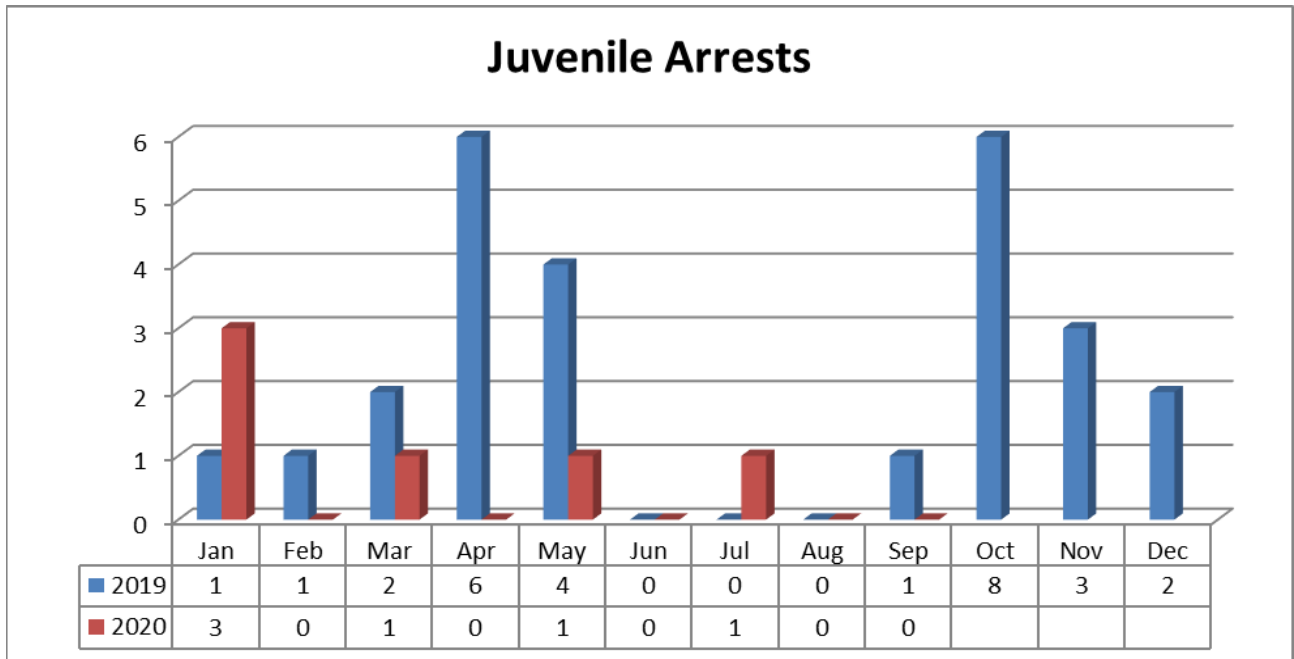
Adult and Juvenile Arrests YTD 2019 and 2020

Robbery: In District 4 in the parking lot of the Hilton Garden Inn, 1800 Powell St., a robbery at gunpoint occurred. LOSS: \$4500 Cash and an iPhone. SUSPECT: A male wearing a mask, no further description. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Newer model Jeep SUV, gray. In District 5 in front of Lenscrafters, 5707 Christie Ave., several juveniles robbed and beat an 18 year old male who was seated in his vehicle. The juveniles were the same individuals involved in the civil unrest incident at the Bay Street Mall. LOSS: A backpack, cell phone, keys, and wallet. The wallet was recovered nearby without its contents. **At Ross Dress for Less, 5733 Christie Ave.,** A male and female couple shoplifted merchandise. Upon exiting the store, the female threatened to stab a loss prevention agent if the agent did not get out of her way. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Toyota, possibly a Camry, silver. **At Ross Dress for Less, 5733 Christie Ave.,** a male shoplifted merchandise and grabbed two customer's new laundry basket as they exited the store. One of the customers chased the suspect, pepper sprayed him, and recovered their laundry basket. The suspect fled the area with the store's merchandise. **In the parking lot of Trader Joe's 5700 Christie Ave.,** a strong-arm robbery occurred. LOSS: Purse. SUSPECTS: (3) Males, 15-25 years old. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Honda Civic, black with black rims. **At Banana Republic, 5695 Bay St.,** a female shoplifter punched the store manager in the face, fled to a double parked vehicle, got in on the driver's side and left the area. LOSS: (2) Pairs of jeans. SUSPECT: Female, late 40s, 5'6", 130 lbs., with short curly honey blonde hair. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Honda CRV, blue.

Aggravated Assault: In District 2 at 14XX 65th St., #XXX, a domestic violence incident resulted in a male choking his girlfriend. EPD arrested the male shortly thereafter. In District 5 at 56XX Bay St., a domestic violence incident resulted in a male hitting his girlfriend on the head with a bottle. EPD arrested the male shortly thereafter. At the Bay Street Mall, 5601-5699 Bay St., during a civil unrest incident several juveniles threw rocks at police officers. There were no injuries or arrests.

In District 3 at 1600 63rd St., POE: Window – Broken. LOSS: (6) Seized packages containing Marijuana. At Expression College, 6601 Shellmound St., POE: Main door. LOSS: Apple computer. SUSPECT: Male adult, medium build, wearing a gray zip up, dark colored jeans, white shoes, and brown backpack.

Residential Burglary: In District 3 at 63XX Christie Ave., POE: Storage locker – Pried open. LOSS: Snowboarding equipment. In District 6 at 15XX Park Ave., POE: Bicycle storage area – Bicycle lock cut. LOSS: A bicycle and a bicycle wheel. At 15XX Park Ave., POE: Bicycle storage area – Bicycle lock cut. LOSS: A bicycle.

Arson: In District 3 at 63XX Shellmound St., a mentally ill male subject attempted to light a field on fire and then proceeded to light a window frame on fire to an occupied building. EPD stopped the subject and transported him to John George Hospital.

Auto Theft: (16) Vehicles were stolen this month including one attempt and (3) motorcycles. (8) Vehicles were recovered, (7) of which were recovered intact, and (1) vehicle had minor stripping. Hondas were the most popular vehicles stolen.
