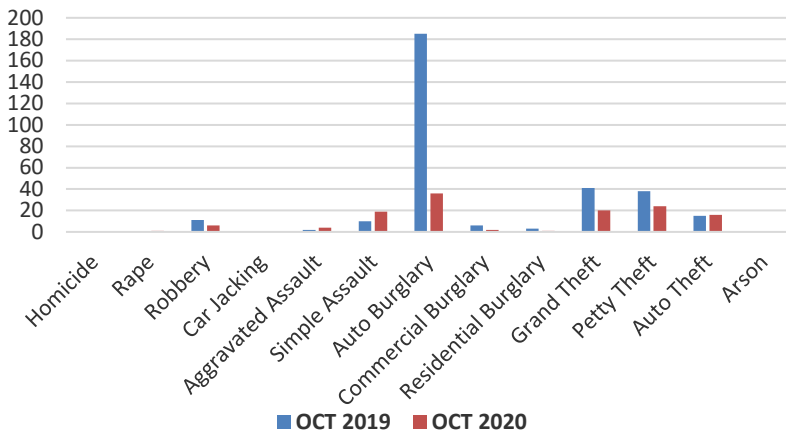

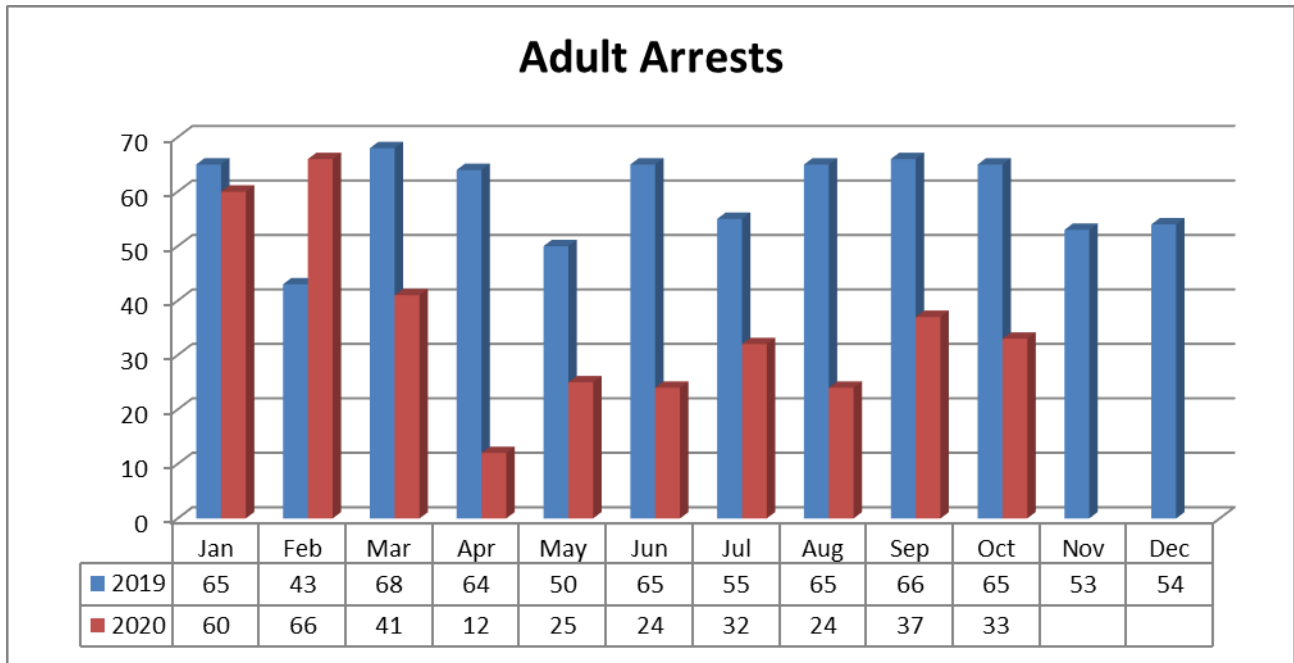

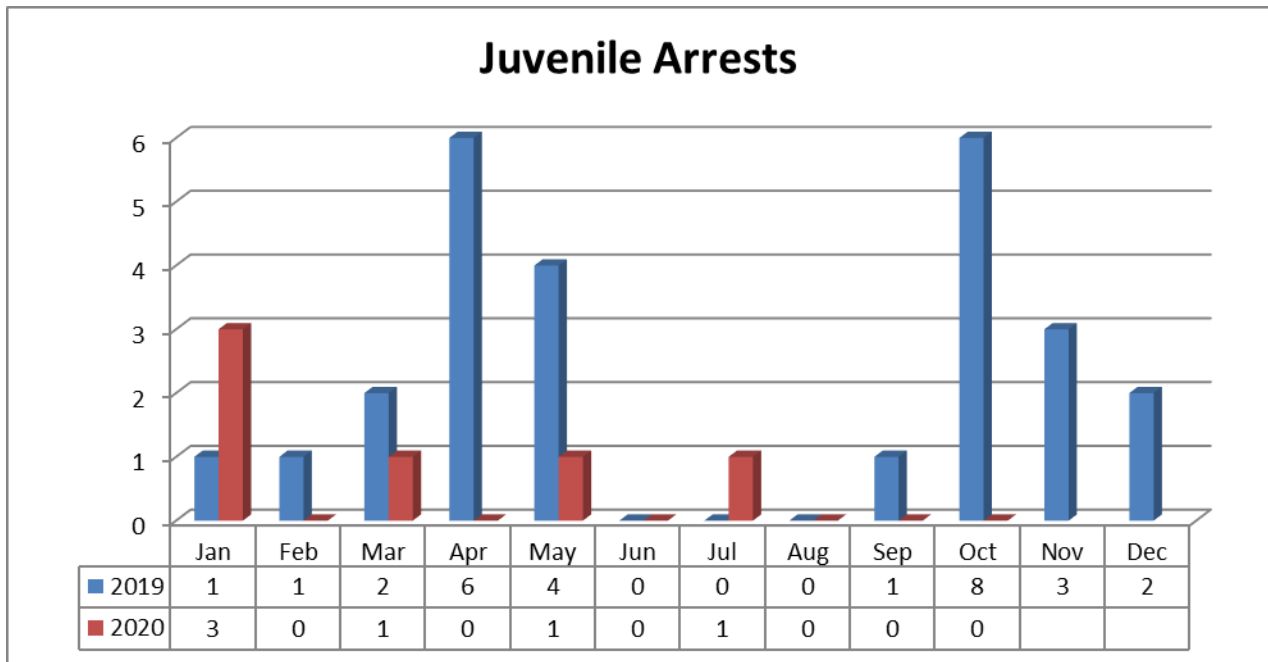
Adult and Juvenile Arrests YTD 2019 and 2020

Rape: In District 5 on the 5500 block of Shellmound St., a sexual assault occurred. Victim: Older male. SUSPECT: Male.

Robbery: In District 4 at Bay Super Shell, 1800 ½ Powell St., a male shoplifter robbed the convenience store at knifepoint. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. LOSS/RECOVERED: (2) cases of beer. In District 5 at Old Navy, 5777 Christie Ave., a female shoplifter grabbed a stack of jeans and exited the store without paying. A store employee recovered the loss from the shoplifter, however the shoplifter's male accomplice intervened and threatened to "pop" the store employee. In front of BevMo, 5717 Christie Ave., a strong-arm robbery occurred. The suspect approached the victim from behind and snatched her purse. LOSS: A purse. SUSPECT VEHICLE: A small sedan, silver. In District 7 at Emery High School near the Gym, 1100 47th St., a male victim posted an ad on OfferUp to sell his Air Jordan shoes. The victim met with the suspect and was robbed at gunpoint. LOSS: Air Jordan shoes, a cell phone, and a shoulder bag. SUSPECTS: (3) Males. SUSPECT VEHICLE: KIA 4-Door, white. In District 8 at W MacArthur Blvd & Adeline St., a strong-arm robbery occurred. LOSS: A purse. SUSPECTS: (2) Males wearing dark clothing. SUSPECT VEHICLE: A black sedan. In District 9 at Nordstrom Rack, 3839 Emery St., #100 an attempted robbery occurred. LOSS/RECOVERED: Shoes. SUSPECT: A female shoplifter, who threatened to pepper spray the loss prevention agent. The suspect left the area.

Aggravated Assault: In District 6 at 14XX Park Ave., #XXX, a male choked his wife during a domestic violence incident. EPD arrested the husband shortly thereafter. In District 8 at 10XX 48th St., #X a male choked his wife during a domestic violence incident. EPD arrested the husband shortly thereafter. In District 9 in front of Baskin Robbins, 1199 40th St., an argument between two male patrons resulted in one patron being shot. EPD Detectives identified the suspect who was taken into custody days later. At Pak N Save, 3889 San Pablo Ave., a physical altercation ensued between two female patrons. One of the females suffered a traumatic eye injury.

Commercial Burglary: In District 3 in the garage of Pacific Park Plaza, 6363 Christie Ave., EPD arrested a female responsible for stealing several packages of mail. Some of the stolen packages recovered, were from other apartment complexes in the City.

Residential Burglary: In District 2 at 62XX Doyle St., #XXX an attempted burglary occurred. An unknown suspect removed the window screen and attempted to pry open the window. No entry was made. In District 3 at Pacific Park Plaza, 6363 Christie Ave., EPD arrested a male who was seen attempting to steal a bicycle.

Auto Theft: (16) Vehicles were stolen this month. (12) Vehicles were recovered, (9) of which were recovered intact, (2) vehicle had minor stripping, and (1) vehicle was damaged. Hondas were the most popular vehicles stolen.
