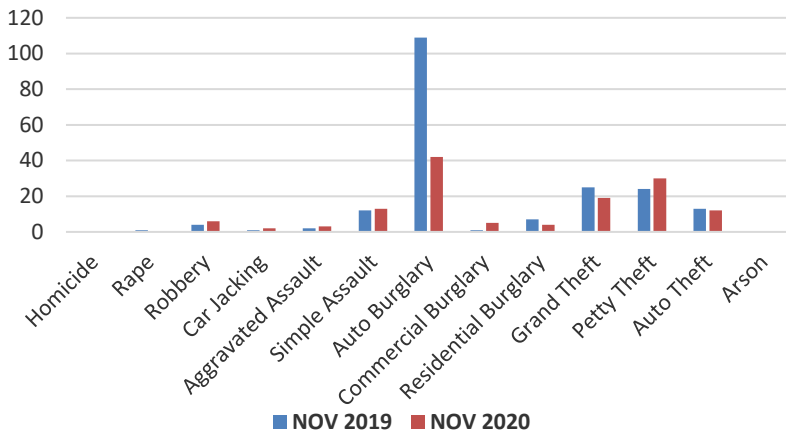

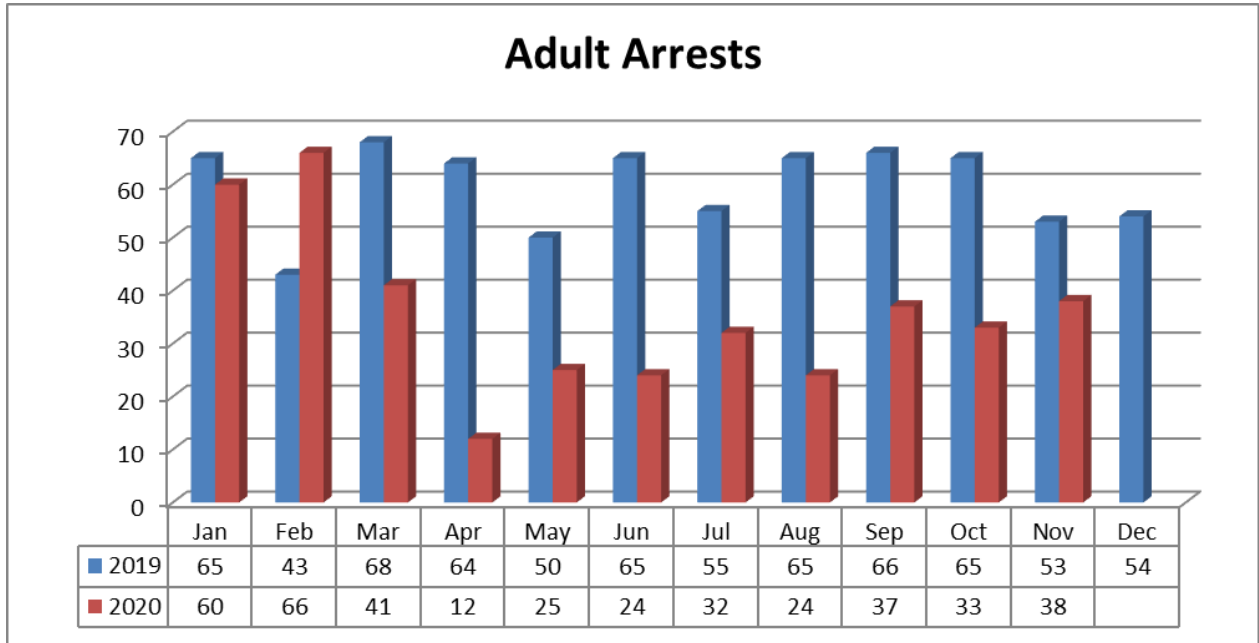

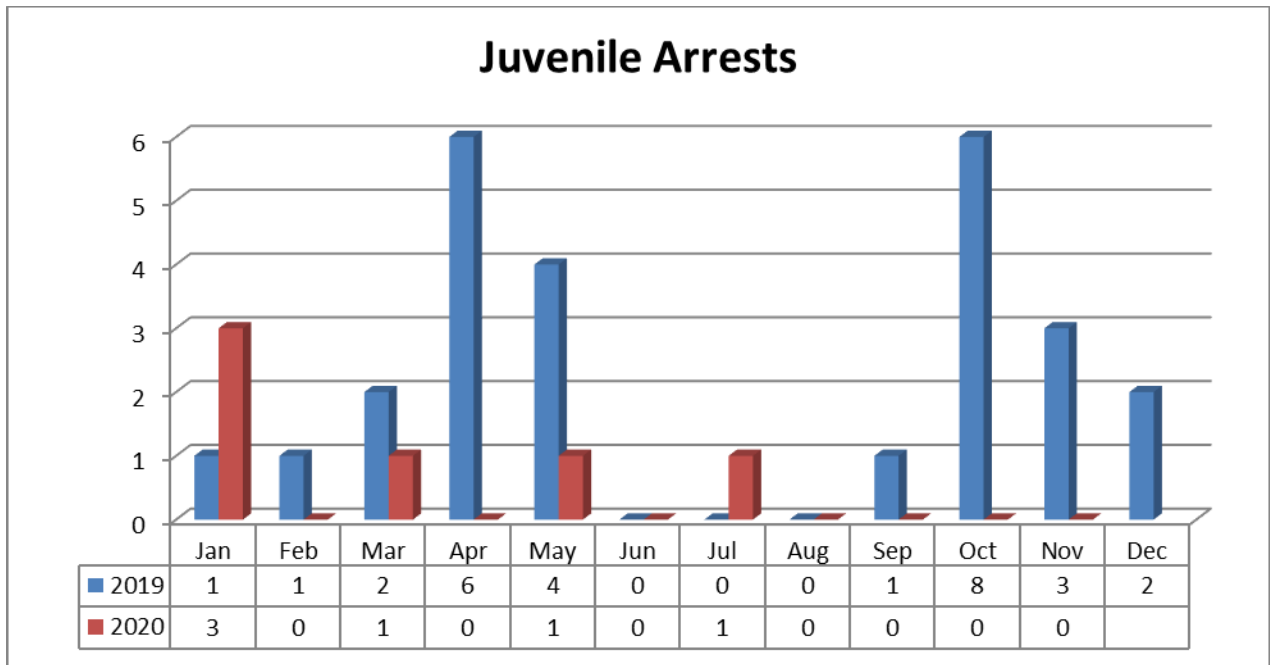
Adult and Juvenile Arrests YTD 2019 and 2020

Robbery: In District 2 on the 6200 block of Doyle St., two male suspects armed with a handgun and a rifle, pistol whipped and robbed a male victim. A third suspect was a female who met the victim in the area. All three suspects fled to an unknown vehicle and left the area. LOSS: Shoes, Backpack, wallet, and a cell phone. In District 5 in front of Old Navy, 5777 Christie Ave., two suspects, one armed with a firearm, pistol whipped a female and grabbed her purse and cell phone. The suspects fled to a vehicle and left the area. A witness followed the suspect vehicle, however an occupant from the suspect vehicle fired several shots at the witness. The witness was not injured. The suspect vehicle was stolen, carjacked, on the previous day from the parking lot of the Target store in Emeryville. (See carjacking below). At Ross Dress for Less, 5733 Christie Ave., a robbery at gunpoint occurred. LOSS: Cash from the register. SUSPECT: Male, 6'0", 200 lbs., wearing a black sweatshirt, and gray sweatpants. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Plate unknown, Infinite, dark gray, 4-Door. In District 7 at CVS Pharmacy, a robbery at gunpoint occurred. Multiple male suspects broke into the pharmacy section. LOSS/Recovered: Prescription medication. EPD arrested one suspect shortly thereafter. The other suspects fled the area in multiple vehicles. In District 8 at 7Eleven, 4000 San Pablo Ave., a shoplifter concealed candy in his pocket, pushed the sales associated and left the store without paying. LOSS: (3) Snicker bars. SUSPECT: Male, 40s, wearing a black t-shirt, no further description. SUSPECT VEHICLE: 1997 Dodge Caravan, silver. In District 9 in the Home Depot parking lot, a male suspect approached a male victim from behind, knocked him to the ground, simulated a gun, and took the victim's cell phone. When the victim realized there was no gun, he punched and chased the suspect. The suspect fled the area. LOSS: Cell phone. SUSPECT: Male, 5'6", 140-145 lbs., wearing a bright orange ski mask with a white and yellow stripe.

Car Jacking: In District 9 in the parking lot of Nordstrom Rack, 3839 Emery St., #100, two suspects attacked a female from behind took her purse. The suspects fled the area in a vehicle. Minutes later, the suspects returned and stole the victim's vehicle. OPD recovered the victim's vehicle a few days later. This incident is related to the aforementioned robbery in front of Old Navy. SUSPECTS: (3) Males, 18-25 years old. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Volkswagen, white. In District 10 in the parking lot of Target, 1555 40th St., a carjacking occurred. SUSPECT: #1 Male, 20s, 5'9", with a goatee. #2 Female, with a ponytail, and thin build. SUSPECT VEHICLE: 1999 Toyota Camry, gold. EPD recovered the victim's vehicle a few days later.

Aggravated Assault: In District 3 on the 6700 block of Shellmound St., a homeless female threw a full can of food at her boyfriend striking him on the forehead. In the garage of the Bridgewater Apartments, 6400 Christie Ave., a female pepper sprayed another females' vehicle while the victim was inside of her vehicle. On the 6363 block of Christie Ave., a female attempted to reverse her vehicle into male victim while he was talking to his friend. The victim jumped out of the way to avoid being struck.

Commercial Burglary: In District 2 in the parking garage of 5885 Hollis St., POE: Garage door – Suspect gained entry after a resident entered the structure. The suspect cased vehicles and the bicycle storage area. LOSS: None. SUSPECT: Female, no further description. In District 3 at Emeryville Dental Care, 1650 65th St., POE: Roof hatch. LOSS: Tools. At 6001 Shellmound St., POE: Door – Pried. LOSS: Computer equipment. At 6301 Shellmound St., POE: Storage unit – Fence bent to gain entry. LOSS: A Specialized bicycle, red. In District 8 at 3850 San Pablo Ave., POE: Front doors – Pried. LOSS: A Bluetooth speaker.

Residential Burglary: In District 2 at 12XX 63rd St., POE: Unknown. An unknown suspect entered the residence while the victim was asleep. LOSS: A laptop and iPad. In District 6 at 14XX Park Ave., POE: Door – Key pad/Intercom. LOSS: None. In District 7 14XX 45th St., POE: Front door. LOSS: Mail/Packages. In District 7 at 13XX Powell St., POE: Storage unit. LOSS: Miscellaneous Kitchen items.

Auto Theft: (12) Vehicles were stolen this month. (6) Vehicles were recovered, (5) of which were recovered intact, (1) vehicle was damaged and stripped. Honda Accords and Civics were popular this month.
