

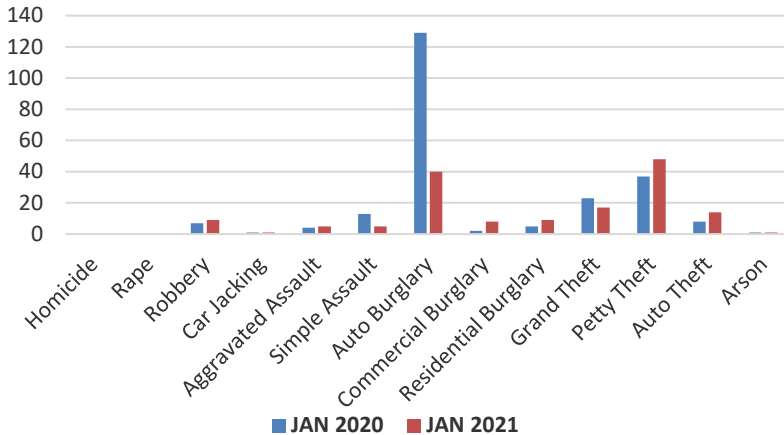

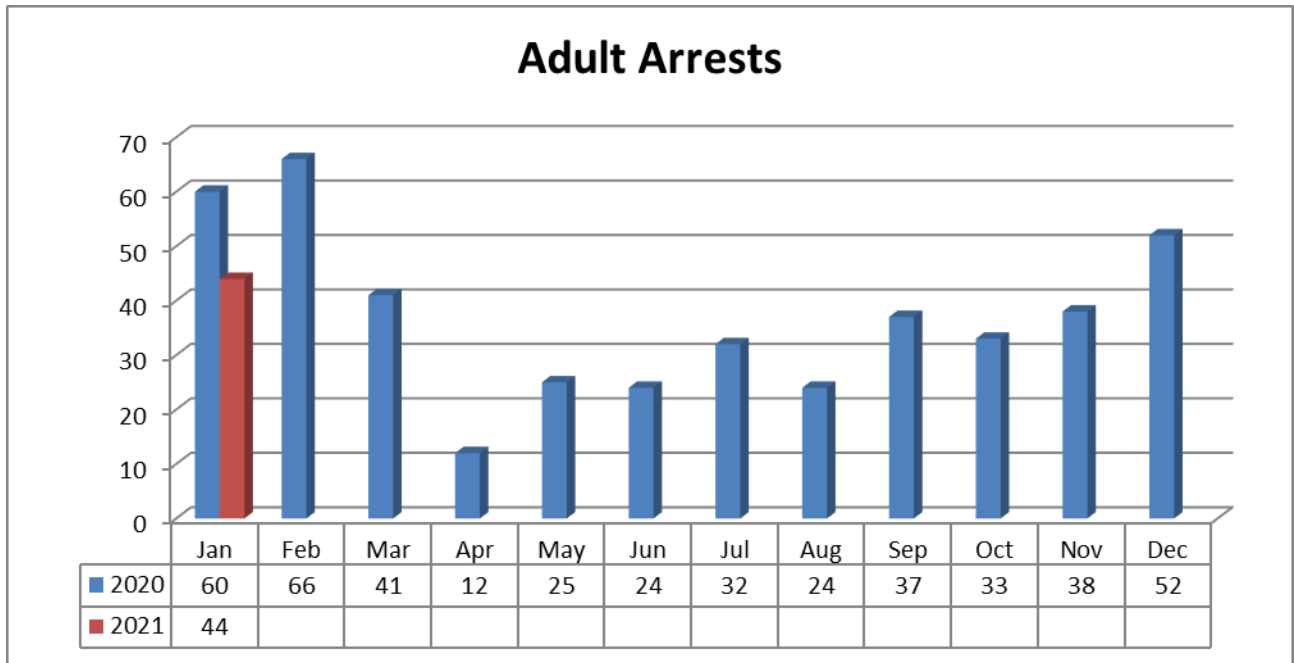

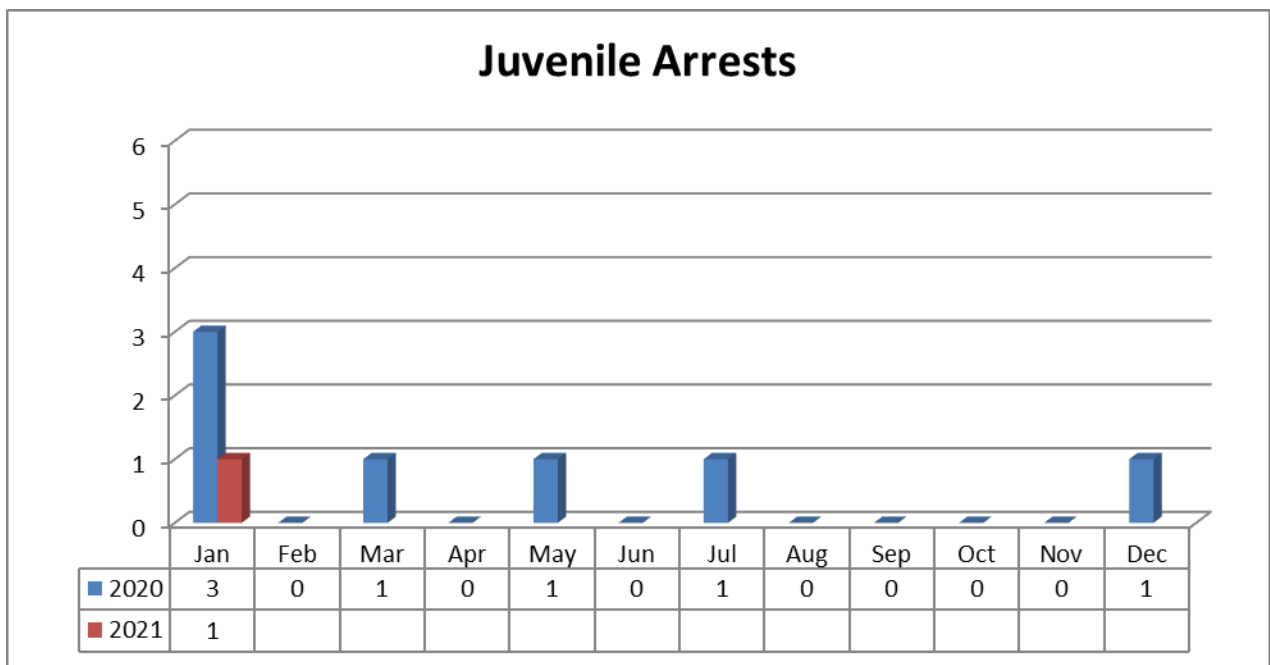
## Adult and Juvenile Arrests YTD 2020 and 2021

**Robbery:** In District 2 at Chevron, 1400 Powell St., a robbery at gunpoint occurred near the gas pumps. LOSS: \$650 dollars. SUSPECT: Male, 6'0", heavy set. The victim knows the suspect. In District 5 at BevMo, 5717 Christie Ave., a strong-arm robbery occurred. SUSPECTS: (2) Shoplifters. #1 male, 40s, 5'11", 170 Lbs., wearing a black beanie, tan overcoat, blue hoodie, and green camouflage pants. #2 male, 30s, 5'11, 170 Lbs., wearing dark clothing. LOSS/Recovered: Various alcoholic beverages. At Togos, 5751 Christie Ave., ATTEMPT. A male suspect simulated a weapon and demanded cash from the register. The employee screamed for another employee, which caused the suspect to flee the business. In District 7 at CVS Pharmacy, 4349 San Pablo Ave., a male suspect simulated a gun in his pant pocket and robbed the business. LOSS: \$3000 dollars. SUSPECT: Male, wearing glasses, a blue hat with ear flaps, a blue jumpsuit, a black scarf, and gloves. POSSIBLE SUSPECT VEHICLE: Black SUV with silver wheels. In District 8 in front of 3706 San Pablo Ave., an unknown male suspect ran up to a vehicle awaiting entry into the garage. The suspect smashed the passenger window, reached in, snatched the driver's purse, and fled the area on foot. In District 9 in the parking lot of Nordstrom Rack, 3839 Emery St., #100 a strong-arm robbery occurred. LOSS: A cell phone. SUSPECTS: (3) males. At Ulta, 3839 Emery St., #200 a strong-arm robbery occurred. A female shoplifter used force to steal merchandise. LOSS: A curling iron and cosmetics. SUSPECT: Female, 5'8", wearing a shoulder length straight blonde wig, and a black puffy coat. In District 10 in the parking lot of Target, 1555 40<sup>th</sup> St., a male suspect stabbed an acquaintance on his arm and robbed him of his bicycle. At Target, 1555 40<sup>th</sup> St., a shoplifter threatened store employees with a knife to steal merchandise. LOSS/Recovered: (2) jackets. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter.

**Carjacking:** In District 3 at 67<sup>th</sup>/Shellmound St., a male victim was carjacked. EPD arrested the suspect and recovered the vehicle a few days later.

**Aggravated Assault:** In District 3 at 63XX Christie Ave #XXX, a male suspect choked his girlfriend during a domestic violence incident. At 64XX Christie Ave., #XXX a male suspect ordered his pit bull to bite his girlfriend during a domestic violence incident. The dog bit the victim on the arm. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. In District 6 at 45<sup>th</sup>/Hollis St., an unknown motorist chased and shot at a male motorist multiple times and fled the area. There were no injuries. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Older GMC van, white. In District 9 at Home Depot, 3838 Hollis St., a male shoplifter placed merchandise in his backpack and attempted to leave the store without paying. An employee recovered the merchandise from the shoplifter's unzipped backpack. The shoplifter then sprayed mace on the employee's face and fled the scene. In the parking lot of Pak N Save, 3889 San Pablo Ave., an argument between a Lyft driver and his female passenger resulted in the passenger spraying mace at the Lyft vehicle.

**Commercial Burglary:** In District 3 at 1650 65<sup>th</sup> St., (Construction site). POE: Door – Pried. LOSS: Several tools and a projector. In District 4 in the lobby of 7 Commodore Dr., POE: Lobby door – Pried. LOSS: Mail. SUSPECTS: #1 male, wearing a face mask, a black hoodie with "Always lit" printed on the front. #2 female, wearing a dark long coat and blue jeans. #3 female, wearing a light-colored coat and dark pants. POSSIBLE SUSPECT VEHICLE: Dodge Charger, dark gray. In District 5 at Sprint 5739 Christie Ave., during closed hours. POE: Unlocked Door. LOSS: (1) iPhone 12. SUSPECT: Male, 5'9", medium build, wearing a beanie, a black mask, and green/black sweater. The suspect arrived at the scene on an undescribed bicycle. In District 6 at PG&E, 4525 Hollis St., two burglaries occurred. POE: Window – Broken. LOSSES: Tools and a PG&E truck. Oakland Police Department recovered the truck the same day, intact. In District 7 at Emeryville City Hall, 1333 Park Ave. POE: Door – Unsecure. LOSS: Oatmeal. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. At 5000 Hollis St., POE: Roll up door – Pried. LOSS: None. In District 10 at Target, 1555 40<sup>th</sup> St., POE: Emergency door – Pried. The suspect pried open display cases. LOSS: Cell phones, cameras, and other electronic devices. SUSPECT: male, wearing a black jacket with a blue shirt underneath, black pants, and light-colored shoes.

**Residential Burglary:** In District 2 at 1572 62<sup>nd</sup> St., ATTEMPT. POE: Door – Unlocked. LOSS: None. A female resident found the suspect standing in her unit. The suspect exclaimed he was in the wrong unit and left the area. SUSPECT: Male, 5'9", thin build, wearing dark clothing. At 14XX 65<sup>th</sup> St., POE: Storage unit – Lock cut. LOSS: Clothing, household goods, and tools. At 14XX 65<sup>th</sup> St., POE: Bedroom closet door – Lock bypassed. LOSS: (5) Bags containing personal documents. At 14XX 65<sup>th</sup> St., POE: Door – Unknown. LOSS: various mail/packages. EPD on viewed the crime and arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. In District 5 at 56XX Bay St., POE: Storage unit – Locks broken. LOSS: Miscellaneous items. In District 7 at 13XX Powell St., POE: Door – Lock bypassed. LOSS/Recovered: Mail. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. In District 8 at 43XX Adeline St., POE: Bathroom window – Broken/screen removed. LOSS: None. The victim knows the suspect. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. At 39XX Adeline St., POE: Bike storage locker in a secure garage. LOSS/Recovered: A bicycle. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. District 9 at 13XX 40<sup>th</sup> St., POE: Unknown. Several mailbox cubbies pried. LOSS: Mail/packages. SUSPECTS: #1 male wearing a black hoodie with "Always lit" on the front. #2 female wearing a pink puff jacket. #3 male wearing dark clothing. #4 female wearing a pink jacket and a longer green jacket carrying a black bag.

**Arson:** In District 5 at Ikea, 4400 Shellmound St., an EPD Officer on viewed a male suspect lighting fire to what appeared to be a bag near the tanbark area. The suspect stomped out the fire when he saw the officer. The officer cited and released the suspect at the scene.
