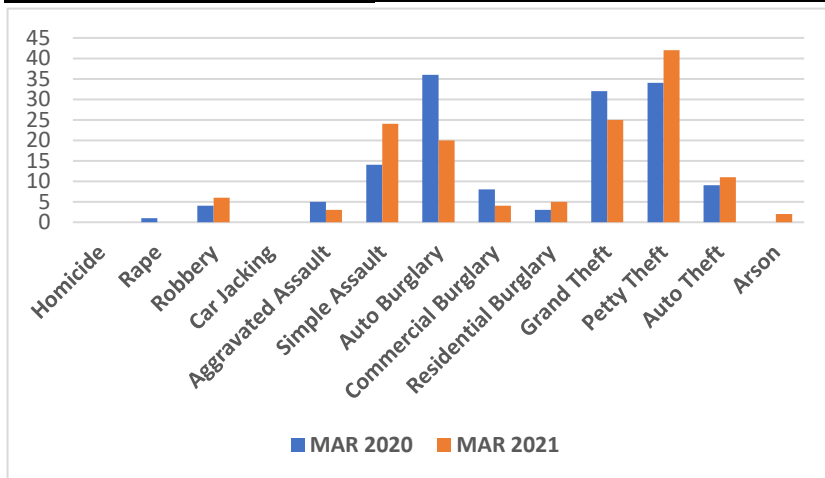

Robbery: In District 5 near Marshall's, 5795 Christie Ave., four suspects pulled an elderly female victim from her vehicle causing her to fall on her hip. LOSS: A purse, a phone, a passport, and a large sum of cash. SUSPECTS: 4 males, 20s, tall and slim, wearing dark hoodies and masks. **At Zumiez, 5677 Bay St.,** a male shoplifter past all points of sale and took merchandise by force. SUSPECT: Male adult wearing a green security vest. LOSS: Hoodie. **At Ross Dress for Less, 5733 Christie Ave.,** a male shoplifter stole clothing by threatening to cut a store employee. No weapons were seen. The suspect fled the store, entered the passenger side of a vehicle, and left the area. SUSPECT: Male, mid 30s, 5'8", wearing a black beanie and a white bandana over his face. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Possibly a 1997 Toyota Corolla, white. **In District 7 at Black and White Market, 4051 San Pablo Ave.,** an irate customer jumped over the counter, took merchandise by force, and left the store. LOSS: A Black and Mild cigar. SUSPECT: Male, mid 20s, wearing a gray hoodie. **In District 8 in front of the Bank Club, 3900 San Pablo Ave.,** a male suspect walked up to the victim, pointed a gun at the victim and demanded the victim's property. The victim dropped his property as he ran away from the suspect. LOSS: A boom box. SUSPECT: Male, 6'3", skinny build, wearing a black hoodie, a white t-shirt underneath, black pants, and black shoes. The suspect was armed with a Glock style firearm with a large capacity magazine. **In District 9 at Pak N Save, 3889 San Pablo Ave., ATTEMPT** a female shoplifter entered the closed business and attempted to take food items by force. EPD arrested the female shortly thereafter.

Aggravated Assault: In District 5 at Ikea, 4400 Shellmound St., LATE REPORT – November 2020. A domestic violence incident resulted in a female using a pair of scissors to cut her husband on his stomach. The husband sustained minor injuries. **In District 8 at ECAP, 3610 San Pablo Ave.,** a mutual combat between male patrons resulted in one patron hitting the other patron on the head with a bicycle lock. EPD arrested one patron shortly thereafter. **In District 9, possibly near Pak N Save, 3889 San Pablo Ave.,** a male adult was shot and is uncooperative with police.

Commercial Burglary: In District 3, Memphis Meats, 5959 Shellmound St., #200, POE: Rear entrance – Key. LOSS: \$1600 cash and a jacket. **At the Smart Building, 5855 Christie Ave.,** POE: Previously broken window. The suspect forced open the inside door to access the business. LOSS/Recovered: Roto hammer, discovered outside the business. **At Public Storage, 6501 Shellmound St.,** POE: Storage unit – Lock removed. LOSS: Coins and stamps. **In District 10 at Target, 1555 40th St.,** ATTEMPT an unknown male attempted to pry open the security door to the fire exit door.

Residential Burglary: In District 3 at 6400 Shellmound St., POE: Unknown. LOSS: Mail, medication, and a driver license. SUSPECTS: (2) male adults. **At 6400 Shellmound St.,** POE: Door – Pry tool. LOSS/Recovered: Mail. EPD arrested three suspects, a male and two females, shortly thereafter. **In District 7, at Parc on Powell, 1333 Powell St.,** POE: Possible key entry. LOSS: Mail. **At Parc on Powell, 1333 Powell St.,** POE: Unknown. LOSS/Recovered: Mail. EPD arrested a female suspect. **At Parc on Powell, 1333 Powell St.,** POE: Unknown. LOSS: Unknown – Mailbox pried, but not opened. SUSPECT: Male, wearing a face mask and blue baseball hat. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Sedan, white, no further description.

Auto Theft: (11) Vehicles including (2) attempted thefts. (4) Vehicles were recovered, (2) of which were recovered intact, and (2) vehicles were damaged. Ford trucks were popular this month.

Arson: In District 3 in front of the Public Market, 5959 Shellmound St., an unknown suspect set fire to what appeared to be a bicycle trailer containing wood and a bookcase. **In District 4 at Powell St., & Admiral Dr.,** an unknown suspect set a vehicle on fire.
