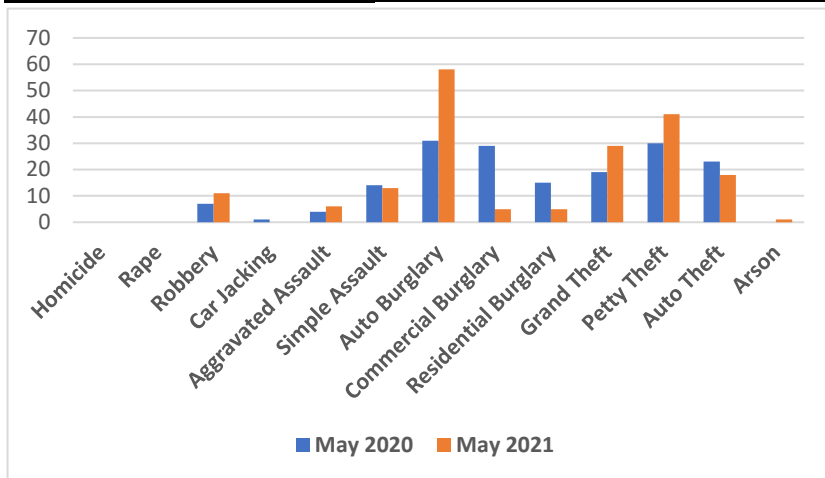

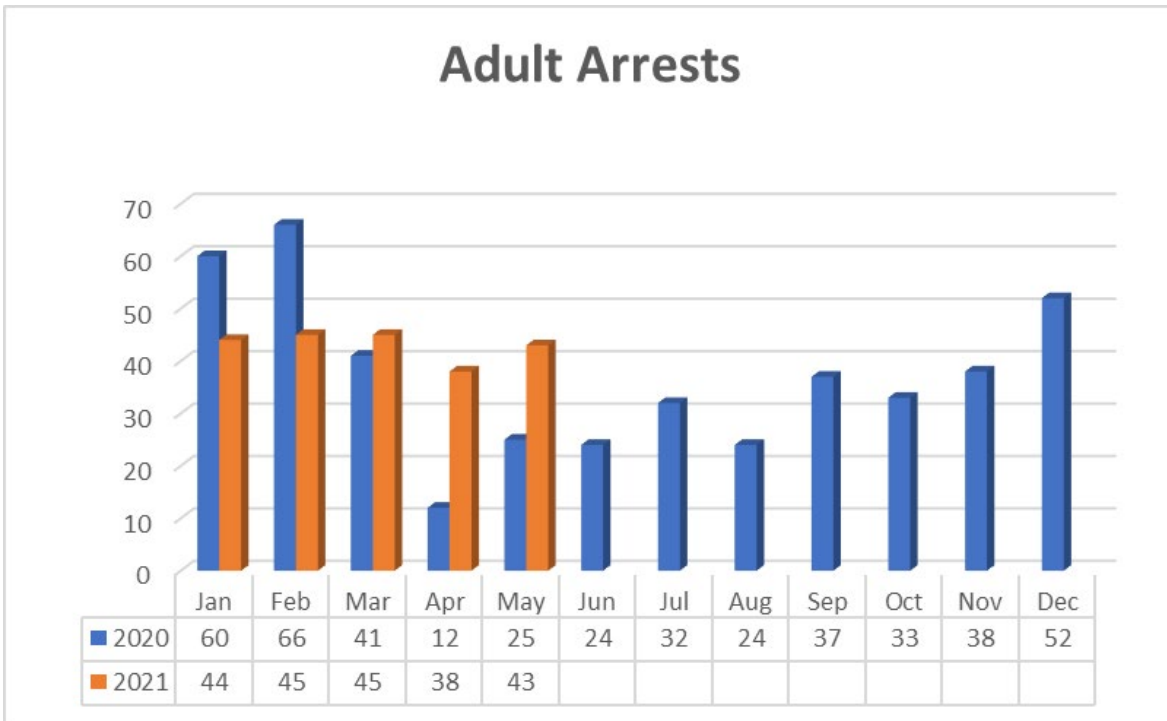

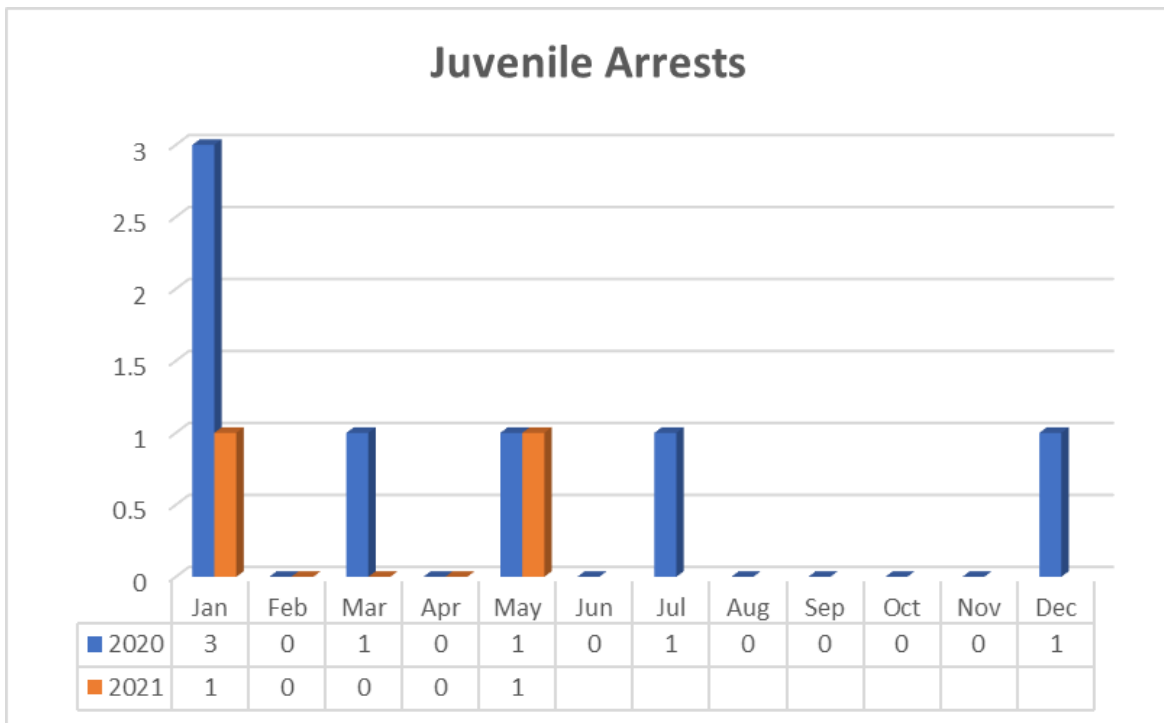

Robbery: In District 4 in front of Watergate Market, 2390 Powell St., a female suspect robbed another female of her purse and fled to an awaiting vehicle. LOSS: Purse containing a wallet, keys, vehicle registration, and cell phone. SUSPECT: Female, 40s, 4'11", petite build, wearing a green windbreaker and green pants. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Possibly a newer model Toyota Prius, black. **In District 5 in the Bay Street Mall Parking Garage, 5601 Bay St., (1st floor)** a male suspect robbed a female of her Purse and walked to an awaiting vehicle. Shortly thereafter the suspect stole the victim's vehicle (recovered with damages by Oakland Police Dept.) LOSS: Purse containing a wallet, keys, cell phone, and credit cards. SUSPECT: Male, 5'4", thin build, wearing a brown hoodie. SUSPECT VEHICLE: A Toyota Prius, black and occupied with three individuals. **At Ikea, 4400 Shellmound St.,** a male suspect robbed a female of her purse. SUSPECT: Male, early 20s, 5'8", skinny build, wearing a blue hoodie. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Toyota Prius, black with two occupants. **At Lenscrafters, 5707 Christie Ave.,** a shoplifter used force to steal merchandise. LOSS: (3) pairs of eyeglasses. SUSPECT: Female in her 60s. **At Uniqlo, 5606 Bay St.,** two shoplifters used force to steal merchandise. LOSS/Recovered: (28) windbreakers recovered by loss prevention. SUSPECTS: (2) Females. **At Zumiez, 5677 Bay St.,** three males, one armed with a gun, entered the store, and ordered everyone down on the floor. LOSS: (2) employees' cell phones, store merchandise, and cash from the register. SUSPECTS: (3) males wearing black masks and black clothing. SUSPECT VEHICLE: A U-Haul box van.

At Victoria's Secret, 5672 Bay St., two shoplifters used force to steal merchandise and flee the store. LOSS: Miscellaneous clothing. SUSPECTS: #1 Female, 30s, 5'10", 300 lbs., wearing a scarf on her head, black shirt, and blue jeans. #2 Female, 5'11", 175 lbs., long black weave, wearing a blue denim jacket, nude sweatpants with "Rugrats" on them, and Jordan shoes. **In District 7 at CVS Pharmacy, 4349 San Pablo Ave.,** two shoplifters used force to steal store merchandise. LOSS: (1) clear bag containing miscellaneous store merchandise. SUSPECTS: #1 Female, no further description. #2 Female wearing a yellow shirt and light-colored jeans. **In District 9 in front of Pak N Save, 3889 San Pablo Ave.,** while the victim counted her money, an unknown suspect snatched the victim's money from her hand and pushed her to the ground. LOSS: \$900. SUSPECT: Male, no further description. **At Home Depot, 3838 Hollis St.,** a male entered the store touting threats, grabbed a power tool and exited the store without paying. SUSPECT: Male, 40s, wearing a brown jacket, black pants, with paint splatter all over his clothing. The suspect left the store riding a silver bicycle. **At Pak N Save, 3889 San Pablo Ave.,** a female punched the store security guard while attempting to load her vehicle with stolen merchandise. The female dropped the merchandise after the security guard sprayed her with pepper spray. SUSPECT: Female, no further description. SUSPECT VEHICLE: 4-Door gold sedan. The loss was recovered.

Aggravated Assault: In District 3 at 63XX Christie Ave., #XXX, an argument between in-laws resulted in one female being hit with a pan and another female being hit with a broomstick. **In District 3 on the 5800 block of Shellmound St.,** a male suspect choked a female he met on a dating site. **At Shellmound & Christie Ave.,** an unknown male approached another male while at the bus stop and struck him on the head with a bat. **In District 8 on the 1000 block of 43rd St.,** an argument between ex-girlfriends resulted in one of the females being dragged a short distance and falling out of a vehicle. (Assaults are counted per victim)

Commercial Burglary: In District 2 at Berkeley Lights, 5980 Horton St., POE: Door- Pried. LOSS: Several Laptops. **In District 3 at Public Storage, 6501 Shellmound St.,** POE: Storage locker lock damaged and forced open. LOSS: (2) laptops, (1) computer tablet, gift cards, personal documents, and a checkbook. **In District 4 at Fish Emeryville, 3310 Powell St.,** POE: Door window – Smashed. LOSS: Selected merchandise. **In District 8 at 7Eleven, 4000 San Pablo Ave.,** POE: Front door – Window smash. LOSS/Recovered: Coins \$10.50. EPD arrested a male suspect shortly thereafter. **At Lane Splitter Pizza, 3645 San Pablo Ave.,** POE: Insecure window – Office rummaged through. LOSS: \$40 in coins.

Residential Burglary: In District 2 at 14XX 65th St., (Garage) two suspects entered the garage and removed a catalytic converter from a vehicle. SUSPECTS: #1 Female, 30s, 6'0" wearing a gray sweater. #2 Male wearing a beanie and face cover. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Gray Audi. **At 61XX Horton St.,** POE: Bicycle storage room. LOSS: Bicycle. **In District 3 at 64XX Christie Ave.,** POE: Garage. An unknown suspect smashed a vehicle window, reached inside the vehicle, and rummaged through a bag on the rear seat. LOSS: None. **In District 8 at 10XX 47th St., (ATTEMPT)** a resident saw a female attempt to enter the security gate using a key. The suspect made a second attempt to enter the gate with a key, however she was unsuccessful. SUSPECT: Female, 30s, medium build with shoulder length hair. **At 39XX Adeline St.,** POE: Insecure garage. An unknown suspect removed a helmet and gloves from a motorcycle.

Arson: In District 9 at Pak N Save, 3889 San Pablo Ave., a male suspect threw a Molotov cocktail against the rear wall of Pak n Save. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter.

Auto Theft: (19) Vehicles including (3) attempted thefts. (12) Vehicles were recovered, (7) of which were recovered intact, (2) Vehicles were damaged, (2) vehicles were damaged and stripped, and (1) vehicle had minor stripping. Honda Accords, Civics, and CRVs were popular this month in addition to thieves targeting older model pick up trucks.
