

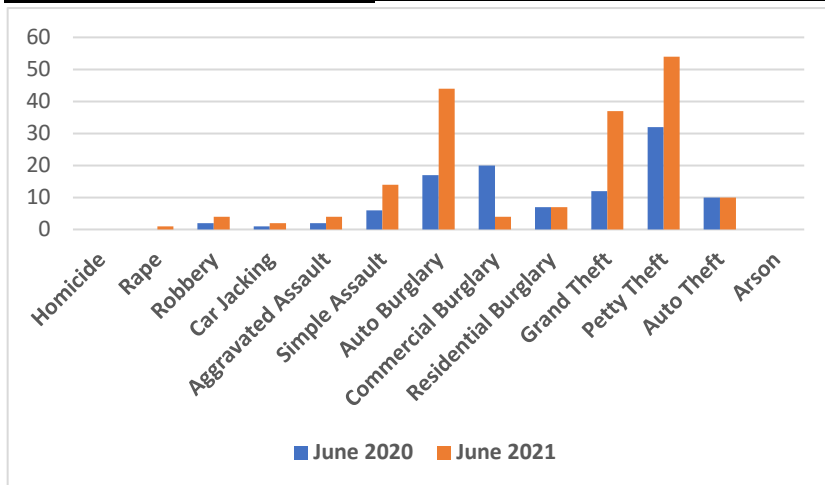

**Rape:** In District 4 on Powell St., a female reported being raped by a male acquaintance.

**Robbery:** In District 4 in the parking lot of Chevy's, 1890 Powell St., a male citizen was robbed at knifepoint. LOSS: \$20 cash. SUSPECT: Male, transient, 40s, wearing a black beanie and black clothing. **In District 9 at Home Depot, 3838 Hollis St.,** a male shoplifter pulled a knife on a security officer and exited the store with merchandise. LOSS: Milwaukee power tool. Suspect: Male, 6'2"-6'3", 210 lbs., wearing a black mask, a long sleeve blue shirt, and dark blue jeans. **At Home Depot, 3838 Hollis St.,** a male shoplifter punched a security officer and left store with stolen merchandise. As the suspect prepared to ride away on his bicycle, he showed security he was armed with a knife. LOSS: Power tool. SUSPECT: Male, 30s, 5'10", 160 lbs., wearing a black mask, a black hat, a black jacket, and blue jeans, riding a blue bicycle. **In District 10 at Target, 1555 40<sup>th</sup> St.,** a shoplifter shoved a store employee and fled with store merchandise. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. LOSS/Recovered: Miscellaneous store merchandise.

**Carjacking: In District 5 at the Bay Street Mall, 5601 Bay St., (2<sup>nd</sup> Level),** a female and her boyfriend were carjacked. SUSPECTS: (3) Males, one armed with a firearm. (2) males exited the suspect vehicle, approached the victims, and demanded the loss (purse, wallet, and victim vehicle). VICTIM VEHICLE: 2005 INFINITI G35. San Francisco P.D. recovered the vehicle a few days later and apprehended a suspect. SUSPECT VEHICLE: GRAY SUV. **In District 9 in the parking lot of 1331 40<sup>th</sup> St.,** (2) males, one armed with a screwdriver, carjacked another male. VICTIM VEHICLE: 2011 Honda Accord. Stockton-CHP recovered the vehicle the same day and arrested both suspects.

**Aggravated Assault: In District 8 on the 4600 block of Adeline St.,** a male victim interrupted (3) male suspects who were attempting to remove the victim's catalytic converter from his vehicle. One of the suspects brandished a firearm at his side and told the citizen to back up as they fled the area. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Chevy Suburban, white. **On the 4000 block of Adeline St.,** an unknown suspect shot at a male victim shortly after the victim was attacked by several people. All participants fled the area prior to police arrival. There were no shooting injuries reported. **At 37<sup>th</sup> & San Pablo Ave.,** an unknown suspect struck a male bicyclist on the back of his head and stabbed the bicyclist on his hand.

**Commercial Burglary: In District 3 at Public Storage, 6501 Shellmound St.,** an employee interrupted two suspects who burglarized a storage unit and had the property from the storage unit sitting on the ground. The suspects fled the area. SUSPECTS: #1 Male, blue eyes, late 20s, tall, with a shaved head. #2 Male, 5'5", skinny, wearing a construction jacket. **In District 7 at 4514 Hollis St., ATTEMPT,** an unknown suspect backed a truck into the rollup doors, then fled the area. LOSS: NONE. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Dark truck. **In District 8 at Pizza Amigos, 5000 Adeline St.,** POE: Front door – Smashed. LOSS/Recovered: Cash register drawer and receipts. **In District 9 at Decathlon, 3938 Horton St., ATTEMPT,** an unknown suspect backed a truck into the front double doors, then fled the area. LOSS: NONE. SUSPECT: Male wearing a face covering. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Nissan Frontier pickup, red.

**Residential Burglary: In District 3 at 64XX Christie Ave.,** POE: Garage. LOSS: Catalytic converter. EPD arrested two males shortly thereafter. **At 63XX Christie Ave.,** POE: Mailroom. LOSS: Multiple packages. **In District 5 at 15XX Brunswig Lane,** POE: 1<sup>st</sup> Floor area. An unknown suspect tampered with the mailboxes. LOSS: NONE. **In District 7 at 13XX Powell St.,** POE: Mailroom. LOSS/Recovered: Mail. EPD arrested a female suspect shortly thereafter. **In District 8 at 11XX 40<sup>th</sup> St.,** POE: Bicycle storage locker. LOSS: Trek bicycle. **At 36XX San Pablo Ave.,** POE: Front Door-Unsecure. LOSS: Backpack. **In District 9 at 12XX 40<sup>th</sup> St.,** POE: Front Door – Possible key entry. LOSS: (2) Playstations, clothing, and shoes.

**Auto Theft:** (10) Vehicles including (2) attempts (both were motorcycles). (4) Vehicles were recovered, (3) of which were recovered intact, and (1) Vehicle was damaged and stripped. Older model foreign vehicles were popular this month.
