Site History

The Site is located at the corner of Hollis Street and 40th Street in the City of Emeryville, California. The Site is bounded by the City of Emeryville City Hall on the north, Hollis Street on the west, a parking lot on the east, and 40th Street on the south. The rectangular parcel is approximately 33,800 square feet with a 30,100 square-foot warehouse, and is located in a neighborhood consisting of commercial and residential properties.

The Site is currently owned by the Emeryville Redevelopment Agency. Previous occupants of the Site included Albert Wright Screw Machines in the 1940s, United Stamping Company in the 1960s through 2006, when the City purchased the Site. In the 1960s through 1980s, Acorn Paper Company was listed at the address; however, no information was found regarding the company.

The City plans to redevelop the Site as a community arts center, with a landscaped area in the southern portion of the Site outside of the building.

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
