**When:** Tuesday, May 22nd at 7 pm.

**Details:** On January 16, 2018, the Emeryville City Council authorized the issuance of a *Request for Qualifications and Proposals* (RFQP) to invite interested private entities to partner with the City to expedite the construction of the Art Center and to identify and implement a sustainable fiscal model for ongoing operations of the facility.

The RFQP *Phase I* (Qualifications Round) has been conducted and three capable and competitive teams have been established based on criteria set forth in the RFQP. The teams will be introduced at the meeting but will not be presenting design or operational model ideas; rather the purpose of this “listening session” is to provide an opportunity for the public to remind the City and potential partners of the “key design and operational needs” of the Center as well as to identify some “wants where possible” ideas before proposals are developed.

The meeting format is intended to encourage members of the community to speak to their current expectations for what they’d like to see in the facility. The City is seeking input on the initial, higher level, design needs of the center. As form follows function, it is important that members of the Art Sector-Business Community and residents/other business owners contribute to the discussion.
